

# Are You Interested In Joining Our Corps?

We welcome members of our community who have a passion for helping our neighbors in their time of need and who want to learn critical, life-saving skills. We are seeking EMTs as well as Driver/Lifters. All training is provided, requirements are:

- Must be age 16 years or older to enroll in Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) course; enrollment is required before you are eligible to ride with us
- Must be at least 21 years of age to become a driver/lifter, and pass CEVO class and practical training
- Willing and able to dedicate the time to learn and commit to a weekly shift and work as a team

PRIOR to signing up for the **EMT Course** or the Certified Emergency Vehicle Operator (**CEVO**) driving class, you will be required to obtain a professional level, Basic Life Support (BLS) CPR card for first responders.

The **State of NJ EMT** training is approximately 190 hours of classroom time plus 10 hours hospital observation time. Students are expected to attend <u>all</u> classes, complete reading, practical and homework assignments, and all program objectives in order to be eligible to take the State of NJ EMT certification exam.

The **EMT classes** are offered throughout New Jersey. Bergen and Passaic County have courses available in the Fall, Spring and Summer semesters. **SPACE IS LIMITED AND CLASSES FILL UP IMMEDIATELY ONCE REGISTRATION IS OPEN.** 

**Driver/Lifter** eligibility requires successful completion of the CEVO course, and 20 hours of behind-the-wheel training with a designated leader from our Corps. Must be physically able to lift and assist the team.

As a Ho-Ho-Kus Ambulance Corp volunteer, we ask that you:

- Attend Monthly Meeting (last Monday of the month at 7:30 pm)
- Cover one assigned duty crew shift per week (6 pm 6 am)
- Cover one full weekend shift every 5 weeks (Friday 6 pm through Sunday 6 pm)
- Participate in community events throughout the year
- Maintain skills by taking Continuing Education (CEU) classes
